All scriptures are NKJV unless otherwise noted, particularly TPT (The Passion Translation) and the Open Bible.

Passover 2020

Day 1: Repentance

Do you realize that all the wealth of his extravagant kindness is meant to melt your heart and lead you to repentance?"

Romans 2:4 (TPT)

Personal Repentance

- **Create in us clean hands and pure heart.** Show us our hearts in light of Your way.
 - Ps 24:3-6: "Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord? Or who may stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who has not lifted up his soul to an idol nor sworn deceitfully. He shall receive blessing from the Lord, and righteousness from the God of his salvation."
 - Ps 51:10-12: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit."
- **Repent for leaving our 1st love**
 - Rev 2:2-4: "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love."
- **Being thankless and taking things for granted:**
 - Romans 1:21: "Because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened."
 - Heb 12:1-2: "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."
 - Rom 2:4 (TPT): "Do the riches of his extraordinary kindness make you take him for granted and despise him? Haven't you experienced how kind and understanding he has been to you? Don't mistake his tolerance for acceptance. Do you realize that all the wealth of his extravagant kindness is meant to melt your heart and lead you to repentance?"
- **Giving into fear and not trusting in the Lord**
 - Psalm 23:4 (TPT): "Lord, even when your path takes me through the valley of deepest darkness, fear will never conquer me, for you already have! You remain close to me and lead me through it all the way. Your authority is my strength and peace. The comfort of your love takes away my fear. I'll never be lonely, for you are near."

- 1 John 4:18: “There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear.”
- **Repent of circumstances/pressures/times when we have lost centeredness in Jesus** and did not steward what He gave us: Foxes on the vines (conflict resolution; boundaries; fear/approval of man)
 - Parable of the Faithful and evil servant: Lu 12:35-48; v. 48: “For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.”
 - Song of Solomon 2:15: “Catch the foxes the little foxes that spoil the vines, for our vines have tender grapes”
 - Ps 37:1-6; v.5-6 “Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.”

Corporate Repentance

- **Repent for hanging on to offense**
 - Mt. 7:1: “Judge not, that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you.”
 - Mt. 5:11-12: “Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.”
 - Mt. 6:14-15: “For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.”
- **Speech: Has our speech reflected Christ?** Have we been speaking life?
 - James 3:6: “The tongue is a fire, the very world of iniquity, the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of our life, and is set on fire by hell.”
 - Pro 18:21: “Death and life are in the power of the tongue”
 - Lu 6:45: “A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.”
- **Complacency in the Body of Christ** not taking their place in standing for righteousness.
 - Repent for complacency in spreading the gospel
 - Zeph 1:12: “And it shall come to pass at that time that I will search Jerusalem with lamps, and punish the men who are settled in complacency, who say in their heart, the Lord will not do good nor will He do evil.”
 - Rev. 3:15-18: “So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. Because you say, ‘I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing’—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked— I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white

garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.”

- Repent for fear of man
 - Psalm 23:5: “You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil: my cup runs over.”
 - Proverbs 29:25 “Fearing people is a dangerous trap; but trusting the Lord means safety.”
 - Psalm 27:1: “The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?”
- **Release of boldness that leads to action and evangelism:**
 - Acts 26:20: “First to those in Damascus, then to those in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and then to the Gentiles, I preached that they should repent and turn to God and demonstrate their **repentance** by their deeds.”

Promises of repentance

“Therefore the Lord will wait, that He may be gracious to you; And therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you. For the Lord is a God of justice; Blessed are all those who wait for Him.” Isaiah 30:18 NKJV

Passover 2020

Day 2: Reconciliation

“For when Your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.” Isaiah 26:9

Reconciliation

Personal Reconciliation with God: Walking in intimacy and reconciliation towards the more excellent way and deeper understanding of God’s ways

- **Know and understand the power of God’s Word**
 - John 1:1 “In the beginning was the word and the word was with God, and the Word was God.”
 - John 19:28 “After this, Jesus, knowing all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled said, ‘I thirst!’”
 - 2 Tim 3:16 “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.”
- **Cast our cares on Him**
 - Ecc 11:1 “Cast your bread on the water and you will find it after many days.” (By casting bread on the water, we find reconciliation with Him)
 - Phil 4:6: “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”
- **Abide in Him**
 - Knowing God as a continued shelter: Ps 91:1-2, 4, 9, 14 “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High, shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty, I will say of the Lord, ‘He is my refuge and my fortress; My God in Him I will trust.’” (See also v. 4, 9, 14 Psalm 91)
 - Hunger for a deeper place of intimacy, John 6:56-58 “He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever.”
 - Ps 89:14-19: “Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Mercy and truth go before Your face. Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! They walk O Lord, in the light of Your countenance. In Your name they rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness they are exalted. For You are the glory of their strength, and in Your favor our horn is exalted. For our shield belongs to the Lord.”
 - Song of Songs 1:4: “Draw me away! We will run after you.” see also v. 14; 5:2
- **Understand and follow the Lord’s direction as He leads us into new things:**

- Is 45:2-3; “To open doors before (me) so that gates will not be shut; I will go before you and make the rough places smooth. I will shatter the doors of bronze and cut through their iron bars. I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden wealth of secret places So that you may know that it is I The Lord, God of Israel who calls you by name.”
- Matthew 27:51-54: “The veil was torn for our reconciliation, no more separation, all may enter the holy of holies through the blood of the Lamb”

Reconciliation between brothers/sisters in the body of Christ action step.

- **God would give us a spirit of reconciliation**
 - Rom 14:19: “Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.”
 - 2 Cor 5:18-19 “Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.”
 - Mt. 5:23-24: “Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.”
 - Romans 12:17-21 “Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord. Therefore
 “If your enemy is hungry, feed him;
 If he is thirsty, give him a drink;
 For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head.”
 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.”

Corporate Reconciliation; Recognize what God is doing and be willing to walk corporately in a new wine skin

- **Open eyes to the new thing God is doing** and be willing to take steps to walk in it.
 - Hab 1:5: “Look among the nations and watch, be utterly astounded! For I will work a work in your days which you would not believe though it were told you.”
 - Is 43:19: “Behold I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; Shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.”
 - Micah 6:8: “He has told me, O man, what is good and what the Lord requires of me, but to do justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.”
- **Compassionate intercession for the Church**, the saints & the prodigals, the following generations. Call prodigals back to the Church.
 - Lu 15:22: ““But the father said to his servants, ‘Bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet. And bring the fatted calf here and kill it, and let us eat and be merry; for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.’ And they began to be merry.”
 - Ezek 37:1-11: v. 4 “Again He said to me, “Prophecy to these bones, and say to them, ‘O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! Thus says the Lord God to these

bones: “Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I am the Lord.””

- **As times change be willing to change and take steps to walk in the new wineskin**
 - Jer 9:23-24: “Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, Let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches; But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me. That I am the Lord exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight says the Lord.”
 - Mt. 9:17: “Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved.”
- **Reconciling all things to Himself.**
 - Col 1:19-21: “For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight—”

Walking in redemptive promise

- **Evangelistic heart and strategies reflecting the love of Jesus**
 - Ephesians 1:6 Mirror Bible: “His grace plan is to be celebrated; He greatly endeared us and highly favored us in Christ. His love for His Son is His love for us.”
 - Eph 1:7 NKJV “ In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.”
- **Open the eyes of the spiritually blind.**
 - 2 Kings 6:17-18: ““Do not fear for those who are with us are more than those who are with them. And Elisha prayed, and said, “Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see.’ Then The Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw.”
- **God will prosper His Kingdom as we rely on Him**
 - Jer 29:11: ” For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”
- **Reconciliation of all things**
 - Col 1:19-20: “For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight— if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.”

Restoration of righteousness in the nations

- Isaiah 26:7-9: “The way of the just is uprightness; O Most Upright, You weigh the path of the just. Yes, in the way of Your judgments, O Lord, we have waited for You; the desire of our soul is for Your name and for the remembrance of You. With my soul I have desired You in the night, yes, by my spirit within me I will seek You early; for when Your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.”
- Psalm 85:10-13: “Mercy and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed. Truth shall spring out of the earth, and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and our land will yield its increase. Righteousness will go before Him, and shall make His footsteps our pathway.”

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Day 3: Revival

“That our faith would not be in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God,” 1 Cor 2:5

Personal Revival

- **Knowing God in His fullness** and majesty (ps 96) in the fear of the Lord
 - 1 Cor 2:5 “That our faith would not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.”
 - Revive me Psalm 119:
 - Turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things and revive me in **Your way** Ps 119:37
 - Behold I long for your precepts; Revive me in **Your righteousness** Ps 119:40
 - Revive me O Lord, according to **Your Word** Ps 119:25, 107, 154
 - Revive me according to **Your justice** Ps 119:149
 - Revive me according to **Your judgments** Ps 119:156
 - Revive me according to **Your lovingkindness** Ps 119:159
 - Psalm 96 relays the majesty of God in times of judgment
- **Our speech would be transformed** through renewed hearts. A new season is upon us and our speech needs to reflect it.
 - Rom 15:18-21: “I will not presume to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me, resulting in the obedience of the Gentiles by WORD and DEED in the power of signs and wonders and in the power of the Spirit so that from Jerusalem about as far as..... I have fully preached the gospel of Christ and this I aspire to preach the gospels. As it is written they who had no news of Him shall see and they who have not heard shall understand. Complete centeredness and trust in Him through humble and contrite heart.
 - Isaiah 57:15: “For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: “**I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to REVIVE the spirit of THE HUMBLE, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.**”
 - **Ps 34:18** “The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.”
- **Bold witness**
 - 1 John 4:17, “Love has been perfected among us in this that we may have boldness in the day of judgment, because as He is, so are we in this world.”
 - Acts 4:13: “Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled, and they realized that they had been with Jesus.”

Corporate Revival and fullness of Gentile Church

- **Pray for the Great Awakening and release of Corporate Prayer**
 - Zech 4:6: “‘Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,’ says the Lord of hosts.”
 - Acts 2:1: “When the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind...and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.”
 - Romans 11:25 “For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.”
- **Pray for the release of prophetic ministry, vision, in the Church.**
 - Joel 2:28: “And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions, and also on My menservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.”
- **Release of the last frontiers of the global harvest**
 - Mt. 24:14: “And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.”
- **Release of revival:**
 - Jeremiah 51:33: “For thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel: ‘The daughter of Babylon is like a threshing floor when it is time to thresh her; Yet a little while and the time of her harvest will come.’”
 - Jeremiah 31:31-34, 38-40 “Behold the days are coming...I will put My law in their minds and write it on their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, ...for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. Behold the city shall be built for the Lord...shall be holy to the Lord. It shall not be plucked up or thrown down anymore forever!”
 - John 1:12 the Mirror Bible; “Everyone who realizes their association in Him, convinced that He is their original life and that His name defines them, God gives the assurance that they are indeed His offspring, begotten of Him; He sanctions the legitimacy of their sonship. (Mankind’s indifference to their true origin is the problem. Jesus has come to introduce mankind to themselves again; mankind has forgotten what manner of person they are by design!) John 1:12 The Mirror Bible
 - John 3:16 The Mirror Bible: “The entire cosmos is the object of God’s affection! And He is not about to abandon His creation - the gift of His Son is for mankind to realize their origin in Him who mirrors their authentic birth - begotten not of flesh but of the Father! In this persuasion the life of the ages echoes within the individual and announces that the days of regret and sense of lost-ness are over!”

Future Promise

“And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, “Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be

their God. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.” Rev 21:3

“And the Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let him who hears say, “Come!” And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. Rev 22:17
